The goal

Your teen is making one small useful project in three guided days.

- A finished small project is better than a giant unfinished idea.
- You do not need to teach coding or become the AI expert.
- Your job is encouragement, account approval, and common-sense boundaries.

What counts as finished

A project can be simple and still count.

- It does one clear job for a real person.
- The teen can show the main action working.
- They can explain what they made and what they would improve next.

Your next steps

Keep the experience calm and practical.

- Review the safety agreement together.
- Set aside short build blocks instead of one long marathon.
- Ask to see what they made at the end of each day.
